Dear IARM President

I'm writing to inform you about a very difficult decision as a consequence of the Corona Virus epidemic that has reached already the 'very serious' level according to WHO, and the announcement of 'pandemic' is already under consideration. In all of the neighboring countries of Hungary there are already positive cases, and the situation in North Italy is the most serious one in the region. There is no experience with this virus and it is questionable whether with the improvement of the weather a decline could be expected or not.

In this case on the one hand, we would be irresponsible to encourage people to travel into a region with increasing health risk and/or oblige themselves to participate an event when nobody can forecast the health hazards in six month. On the other hand, scientists from Japan, South Korea, Italy etc. would very likely not wanted to take the risk and oblige themselves to join to the IARM Conference in the region with increasing epidemiologic hazard. (A number of events with high prestige were already cancelled or postponed. Even the Olympic games in Japan are still under consideration, as far as I know.) That is the background of the painful decision that we have to cancel the IARM conference planned for August this year. There was no reason for the 'postponement' of it, because for the next year there is already a decision for the conference in Belgrade. I'm seriously disappointed with this development, but it was a collective decision of our leadership.

I and my colleagues would like to ask for your kind understanding.
